- **Always place candles well away from curtains and furniture and always out of draughts.**
- **Don't let candles fall over! You need to keep candles firmly upright in a proper holder.**
- **Always use a glass or metal holder for scented candles and tea lights, which melt into liquid wax.**
- **Always place candles on heat resistant surfaces. Night lights and tea lights can melt plastic surfaces such as TV tops and bathtubs.**
- **Don't lean across candles! You could set fire to your clothes or hair.**
- **Don't put candles under shelves or other surfaces.**
- **Always put out candles before you move them.**
- **Keep candles out of reach of children and pets.**
