

Activity 3 - Firework safety

- Ask children if they can think of some rules to ensure safety when dealing with fireworks. Discuss and write sensible ones on the board.
- Look at 'The Firework Code' poster. Discuss any that they hadn't mentioned.
- Make a poster each or in pairs, picking out one firework rule each.
- **Or** - write a story aimed at younger children to highlight the firework rules and what may happen if they don't stick to them.
- **Or** - in pairs or small groups create a presentation, using an ICT package such as PowerPoint, on firework rules, using illustrations and animations to make it more interesting.
- **Or** - in pairs or small groups prepare a piece of drama that could be used as an imaginary advert to inform children or adults of firework rules.
